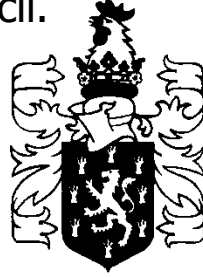

Garden Rubbish:

Telephone Books, Yellow Pages, Pet Straw, Untreated Sawdust and Wood Shavings, Cut Flowers, Shredded Paper, Cold Ash
